Delegates are required to undertake a project which contributes to the overall assessment.

Certification:

Successful delegates will receive a CISRS Overseas Scaffold Supervisor Certificate of Training and Record Card.

Notes:

Translator required if instructor cannot speak the language.

A renewal course is required within every five years.

Trainees will require suitable PPE to undertake practical scaffold inspection.

A maximum of 12 learners per course is permitted.
