

CISRS (OSTS) Scaffold Inspection Course

Duration: 2 days

Attendees:

This course is intended for persons responsible for inspecting and checking scaffolds for safe use and for signing certificates and registers in accordance with statutory and local regulation.

Attendance of 12 learners per course. Objectives:

The overall aim is to develop in delegates an understanding of the appropriate local Safety regulation and the ability to interpret design specification technical requirement when inspecting complex/design scaffolding structure.

Content:

At the end of the training the learner will be able to:

Interpret Scaffold design drawing for inspection purposes and will be able to inspect and record the finding of such an inspection for:

A Basic Design Scaffold Two-Way
Shore
Dead Shore Slung scaffold
Staircase scaffold Temporary
Roofs Truss-out scaffold
Temporary ramps Cantilever
drop

Competence is measured by multi choice examination and practical scaffold inspection examination.

Certificate:

CISRS Certificate of training upon completion of course and successful completion of both examination.

Notes:

The Scaffold Inspection qualification requires renewal within five years.

Trainees will require suitable PPE to undertake practical scaffold inspection in accordance with local requirement.
